

OS MAC

Connecting Printers



- Navigate to System Preferences → Print and Scan
- Click the + button to add a new printer
- Control-Click (or mouse right-click) on the Toolbar and select Customize Toolbar
- Drag the **Advanced icon** onto the bar, then click the newly added Advanced button
- Select Type: Windows printer via spoolss device type
- Enter a Device URL, such as: **smb:**//**rov-services.unitn.it/printer_name** (Tip: printer_name is the printer's share name; i.e. "PF_CC_p2_NordEst_Colore")
- In Name field, enter a friendly and informative printer name. (i.e. "TOSHIBA e-Studio 2820c")
- Choose a **driver** for this printer by pulling down the drop-down box and selecting Select Software (if the proper driver is missing, download it before this procedure)
- Click the Add button
- Test print and when asked use the correct UNITN credentials. (see image below)



N.B.: Printers all have a name (it also appears on the label on them) composed as follow: **PI_p0_Portineria_Colore**

- **PI** (o PF) = Palazzo Istruzione (o Palazzo Fedrigotti)
- **p0** = Ground Zero
- **Portineria** = Place identification where the printer is located
- **Colore** = Printer type (Color or Black and White)

CRITICAL: If you changed your Unitn password, you must reinsert it in the credential of installed printers. For this, navigate to System Preferences \rightarrow Print and Scan and here double click on the selected printer. It's open a printer queue, here click on the circle near the x icon and reinsert the new Unitn password with option checked Remember password in Keychain
